

2019-20 Selection Policy

Under 17 Team Events:

- Event** - 2020 Interprovincial – 4th & 5th April (Day TBC) Dublin
- Team size: minimum 4 boys & 4 girls, maximum 6 boys & 6 girls
 - Selection date: 16th February
 - Provisional Team Announced: 17th February 2020

1. Policy Objectives

1.1 To select a team to represent Ulster in the above mentioned Team Event.

2. Performance Targets

2.1 To select the best possible players that will perform with distinction in the above Event.

3. Player Eligibility

3.1 Only players who are eligible to play for Ulster will be considered for selection

3.2 Players who were born in 2004 or after

3.3 Be a paid up and affiliated of, and in good standing with Badminton Ireland

4. Primary Selection Criteria

4.1 The following domestic tournament results for the **U17 Interprovincials** will be considered by the panel:

- U17 International & U17 UK events.
- Ulster U17 Open- 14th-15th September 2019
- Leinster U17 Open- 5th & 6th October 2019
- Munster U17 Open- 2nd & 3rd November 2019
- Connacht U17 Open – 4th-5th January 2020
- U17 Irish Nationals- 15th-16th February 2020

Consideration will be given to the competition format when selecting the team. Player's must play a minimum of the Ulster U17 Open plus 1 other of the above events to be considered for selection.

4.2 In the situation where two or more players have the same results, other tournaments may be considered by the panel. These results will only come into consideration if U17 tournaments cannot separate two or more players

4.4 The panel reserves the right to review the behaviour of all players in previous Team Events when considering their selection for Events.

5. Secondary Selection Criteria

5.1 Where selection of two players cannot be separated in 4.2, one wildcard selection for each gender can be used. These players do not have to fulfil the primary selection criteria, but must be viewed as high potential by the panel.

5.2 In the situation where a number of players are not available for selection, other players with a track of record of success at Ulster Junior League or Ulster Schools competition/league level (who don't meet policy 4.1) can be selected to ensure the success of policy 2.1

6. Player Availability for Preparation and Competition

6.1 Upon selection of the provisional team, the player must confirm their availability for the duration of the competition.

6.2 The player must be also committed to the preparation process prior to the U17 Interprovincials which will be training sessions on the dates below: Please notes these dates are Provisional and will be confirmed ASAP:

- Thursday 5th March – 7-9pm- Venue- TBC
- Sunday 15th March – 1-3pm- Venue- TBC
- Sunday 22nd March – 1-3pm- Venue- TBC
- Sunday 29th March – 1-3pm- Venue TBC

7. Overriding Factors

7.1 Should a player with an established record of high level results become injured and is unable to compete in the majority of the selection tournaments, then this player may still be considered for selection based on previous performances subject to passing a suitable fitness test

7.2 If an injury occurs to a player after nomination they will be required to demonstrate an appropriate level of fitness (determined by the coaches) to remain as a selected player.

7.3 If an injury occurs to a selected player after nomination it is possible for a replacement player to be selected if in the interests of the team and permitted by the event organisers

9. Appeal Process

9.1 Any player that feels they should have been selected for a team based on the criteria in this selection policy are advised to firstly consult the Ulster Programme Performance Co-Ordinator.

9.2 Appeals in respect of selection should be made in writing to Ulster Badminton, marked for the attention of the Chairman. Appeals must be submitted within 72 hours of the announcement of the provisional team.

9.2 The sole ground for an appeal is that the selection policy was not properly followed.

9.3 An appeal must be made in writing by letter with appropriate and sufficient supporting documentation and must be accompanied by a deposit of £30, payable to Ulster Badminton. If the appeal is upheld the deposit will be refunded in full.

9.4 The Appeals Committee will comprise three people, one of whom is required to have elite sport experience that will investigate the issues of the appeal with all involved parties. No member of the Appeals Committee shall have been involved in the selection process.

9.5 The Chairman will in writing inform all parties about the Appeals Committee's decision to either uphold or reject the appeal.
