

## 2019-20 Selection Policy

### Ulster A Grade Team Events:

Event B - National Interprovincial – 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> April (Dublin)

- Team size: minimum 4 men & 4 ladies, maximum 6 men & 6 ladies
- Selection date: 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2020

### 1. Policy Objectives

1.1 To select a team to represent Ulster in the above mentioned Team Event.

### 2. Performance Targets

2.1 To select a team that is capable of performing with distinction at the Interprovincial

### 3. Player Eligibility

- 3.1 Only players who are eligible to play for Ulster will be considered for selection
- 3.2 Be a paid up and affiliated of, and in good standing with Badminton Ireland

### 4. Primary Selection Criteria

4.1 The following tournament results for the A Grade Interprovincial team will be considered by the panel in preferential order:

- 2019-20- Provincial Premier tournaments & Premier Irish Nationals
- 2019-20- Provincial A Grade tournaments & A Grade Irish Nationals
- 2019-20- U19 Provincial Tournaments.
- 2019-20- Provincial Masters tournaments & Masters Irish Nationals

Consideration will be given to the competition format when selecting the team. Player's must play the Ulster Premier or Ulster A Grade or U19 Ulster Open plus 1 other of the above events to be considered for selection.

4.2 In the situation where two or more players have the same results, other tournaments may be considered by the panel. These results will only come into consideration if the above tournaments cannot separate two or more players

4.3 In the situation where a number of players are not available for selection, other players with a track record of results in national or provincial League competitions (who don't meet policy 4.1) can be selected to ensure the success of policy 2.1

4.4 The panel reserves the right to review the behaviour of all players in previous Team Events when considering their selection for Events.

### 5. Player Availability for Competition

5.1 Upon selection of the provisional team, the player must confirm their availability for the duration of the competition and must commit to the preparation process prior to each event.

### **Player Availability for Competition & Training.**

5.1 Upon selection of the provisional team, the player must confirm their availability for the duration of the competition and must commit to the preparation process prior to each event. Training dates will be confirmed closer to the stated event.

## **6. Overriding Factors**

6.1 Should a player with an established record of high level results become injured and is unable to compete in the majority of the selection tournaments, then this player may still be considered for selection based on previous performances subject to passing a suitable fitness test

6.2 If an injury occurs to a player after nomination they will be required to demonstrate an appropriate level of fitness (determined by the Senior Team Coach) to remain as a selected player.

6.3 If an injury occurs to a selected player after nomination it is possible for a replacement player to be selected if in the interests of the team and permitted by the event organisers.

## **8. Appeal Process**

8.1 Any player that feels they should have been selected for a team based on the criteria in this selection policy are advised to firstly consult the Ulster Programme Co-ordinator (TBC).

8.2 Appeals in respect of selection should be made in writing to Ulster Badminton, marked for the attention of the Chairman. Appeals must be submitted within 72 hours of the announcement of the provisional team.

8.3 The sole ground for an appeal is that the selection policy was not properly followed.

8.4 An appeal must be made in writing by letter with appropriate and sufficient supporting documentation and must be accompanied by a deposit of £30, payable to Ulster Badminton. If the appeal is upheld the deposit will be refunded in full.

8.5 The Appeals Committee will comprise three people, one of whom is required to have elite sport experience that will investigate the issues of the appeal with all involved parties. No member of the Appeals Committee shall have been involved in the selection process.

8.6 The Chairman will in writing inform all parties about the Appeals Committee's decision to either uphold or reject the appeal.

Ulster Badminton reserves the right to amend the selection policy in the event of unforeseen circumstances
